ATTENTION MEMBERS: Please fill out entry completely. This information will be used for year end awards.

One horse & rider per form, photocopy more if needed. Entries sent without full payment will be returned. No horse may be ridden by 2 different riders in the same class. Non-Competing Horses are welcome, but must fill out entry form with Coggins and pay the office fee. Stall fees are the same.

Make checks payable to: SWFDA and **mail to the Show Secretary Listed Above:** (no phone entries will be accepted for any reason)

JACKETS: Riding jackets are optional.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders *age 18 and over* while on horses that are competing *only* in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test). Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The headgear and harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

RULES: USEF Rules are used as a guideline. Exceptions will be made with approval from the grievance committee prior to competing. Non-USEF equipment in either the warm-up or competition ring will always require approval and the necessity of riding H.C.

TRAILER PARKING, LOADING, & UNLOADING: Please park in designated parking areas. Once the show has begun, please do not drive, load, or unload in front of the barn unless it is during a break.

COGGINS TEST: COPY OF CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. Florida law no longer requires that copies be notarized.

POST ENTRIES: Will be accepted if the show is not full. These will be on a first come, first serve basis. These must be received by mail with an additional \$25.00 post entry fee. Fee MUST accompany entry or it will not be accepted.

RIDE TIMES: Preferred method of notification is by e-mail. ***Please include your email address on entry form.*** Times will be mailed **ONLY** if a self addressed envelope is enclosed. Ride times can also be found on our website: www.swfda.org.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st through 6th place. High Point Award to highest single score per level. (Must have a minimum of 3 competitors per level for High Point)

FOOTING: Two (if entries warrant) 20 x 60 meter arenas with screenings. Warm-up: grass arena

STABLING: Ample stalls on grounds. No bedding provided. Stalls are available after 12:00 noon on Friday, unless arrangements have been made with management to arrive earlier. Please note any stabling requests on entry form. If you will require overnight security please notify the Show Secretary on or before the closing date to make these arrangements (additional fees will apply). Stalls are \$20.00 day/night. **A separate check of \$10.00 must be submitted with your entry for stall cleaning. (The \$10.00 check WILL NOT be deposited if stall is left stripped per Civic Center Rules). If you chose to leave your stall unclean then your check will be cashed.**

CONCESSION: We are not able to provide any concessions. Please bring your own food/beverages.

DIRECTIONS: 1-75 to exit 143 Bayshore Road/CR78; go east approximately 2.5 miles to Old Bayshore Road and turn left. Horse Show entrance is off Old Bayshore, follow Horse Show Entrance signs.
