Sponsor	\$15.00 (1 class/1show) include 8 business cards for ribbons
Stabling Fees	\$25.00 for the day/\$30.00 for overnight

NON-COMPETING HORSES are welcome, **but must fill out entry form WITH Coggins and pay the office fee.** Stall fees are the same.

ATTENTION MEMBERS: Please fill out entry completely. This information will be used for yearend awards. One horse & rider per form, photocopy more if needed. Entries sent without full payment will be returned. Horses may not be ridden by 2 different riders in the same class.

Make checks payable to: SWFDA and **mail to the Show Secretary Listed Above:** (no phone entries will be accepted for any reason)

DRESS CODE: Riding jackets are optional. Breeches may be either light or dark colored. Shirts must be solid white or light colored **polo** or **riding shirt** with short or long sleeves (*no sleeveless shirts, tank tops or T-shirts*).

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders *age 18 and over* while on horses that are competing *only* in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test). Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet that meets or

exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The headgear and harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. ******PLEASE NOTE! Our insurance company requires that protective headgear be worn for ALL DISCIPLINES, including Western.**

RULES: USEF/USDF Rules and Regulations including the USDF Dressage Protocols are used as guidelines. Exceptions may be made with approval from the grievance committee or show manager prior to competing. Non- USEF equipment in either the warm-up or competition ring will always require approval and the necessity of riding H.C.

TRAILER PARKING, LOADING, & UNLOADING: Please park in designated parking areas.

COGGINS TEST: COPY OF CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. Florida law no longer requires that copies be notarized.

POST ENTRIES: Will be accepted if the show is not full. These will be on a first come, first serve basis. These must be received by mail with an additional \$25.00 post entry fee. Fee MUST accompany entry or it will not be accepted.

RIDE TIMES: Preferred method of notification is by e-mail. *Please include your email address on entry form.* Times will be mailed **ONLY** if a self-addressed envelope is enclosed. Ride times may also be found on our website and/or Facebook page: www.swfda.org and www.facebook.com/SWFLDressage.

AWARDS: Ribbons, 1st through 6th place. High Point Award to highest single score per level. (Must have a minimum of 3 competitors per level for High Point)

FOOTING: Covered show ring- screenings, warmup area – screenings

LUNGEING and GROUP SCHOOLING: Permitted in designated areas only. Please ask show manager.

STABLING: Stabling is limited and provided on a first come, first serve basis. Contact show secretary for availability. Stalls must be left clean.

CONCESSION: We suggest you bring your own food and beverages (NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED).
